

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

(for participants)

GUIDELINE FOR ORAL PRESENTATION

1. Presentation Duration

- Each presenter will be allocated a maximum of **7 minutes** for their presentation, followed by a **2-minute** Q&A session.

2. Presentation Structure

The presentation must include the following points:

- **Title and Introduction:** Introduce the title of the research and its background.
- **Research Objectives:** Clearly outline the primary objectives of the research.
- **Methodology:** Describe the methods used in the research.
- **Findings and Analysis:** Present the main findings supported by data or evidence.
- **Conclusion and Impact:** Summarize conclusions and discuss the research significance or implications.

3. Visual Requirements

- Use clear, professional, and easily understandable **presentation slides**.
- Avoid dense text; use bullet points, charts, or diagrams to support your explanations.
- Ensure all tables, graphs, and images are labelled appropriately.

4. Language and Delivery

- The presentation is delivered in **English**
- Use polite, clear, and concise language.

5. Equipment and Technology

- The presentation will be conducted using equipment provided by the committee (laptop, LCD, and pointer).

- **Presenters are required to submit the presentation materials in PPT format by August 10th, 2026, to ensure compatibility, to this link:**

6. Assessment Criteria

The following aspects will be evaluated by the judges:

- **Clarity of Delivery:** The ability to present ideas in a structured and easily understood manner.
- **Content Quality:** Relevance, innovation, and impact of the research.
- **Data Visualization:** Effective use of slides and visual aids.
- **Q&A Response:** Competence in addressing questions from the audience or judges.

7. Timeliness and Orderliness

- Presenters must ready **15 minutes before their session** for technical preparation.
- Adherence to time limits is highly valued, and presenters exceeding the allotted time will be given a warning by the moderator.

8. Ethics and Compliance

- All presented materials must be original and free of plagiarism and stated a conflict of interest.
- Presenters must acknowledge contributions from their team, institutions, or research supporters.

9. Evaluation

- The judges will evaluate your presentation. Best oral presentation(s) will be rewarded.

GUIDELINE FOR E-POSTER PRESENTATION

1. Prepare a one-page poster document in **JPG or PNG format**.
2. Poster document:
 - a. Layout: Landscape (horizontal orientation)
 - b. Pixels: Minimum recommended size (format W x H) = 1920 x 1080 px
 - c. Size in inches: 19 inch x 11 inch, or 50.7 cm x 28.5 cm
 - d. Format: 16:9
 - e. Minimum font size: 10 pt
 - f. DPI 300 pixels/inch
 - g. File size max 40 MB
 - h. Media: images/photos, graphs, and tables can be included in the e-poster
3. All posters must be written in **English**
4. The title and subheadings should be written in bold.
5. The poster structure for the **Original Research/ Meta-Analysis/ Systematic Review** must have title, authors' name and affiliations, background, methods, results, conclusion, references, and COI (Conflict of Interests) disclosure. Please keep the references list at maximum 5 references, and the content of the poster as concise as possible.
6. The poster structure for **Case Report** must have title, author's name and affiliations, introduction, case presentation, discussion and conclusion, and references. Please keep the references list at maximum 5 references, and the content of the poster as concise as possible.
7. Make sure that any photographs or figures being used in the poster are with sufficient size and sharpness so that they are clearly visible. The number of photographs should be limited to only those that are essential and relevant for the poster. Graphs and tables should be well organized.
8. At the upper left corner of your poster, please type your **Code Number**
9. At the bottom of the poster, please mention: **Presented at The 10th International Conference on Translational Medicine and Health Sciences (ICTMHS) – 2026**
10. **Please send the e-poster file by August 10th 2026 to ensure compatibility, to this link:**

11. **Please submit with the file title: Code_Screen Number_Name [Example: 003_1_My Name]**
12. All posters will be subjected to evaluation. The judges will walk around to evaluate your poster and/or ask questions. Best poster(s) will be rewarded.
